What is this ECHO?

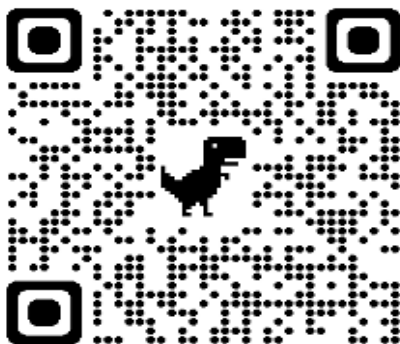
